Crack will help your computer to work faster and give you access to the internet..Q: Powershell script works from command line but not from scheduled task I am trying to run a powershell script every 5 minutes in a scheduled task on Windows Server 2012. I am running the script from my local powershell version: C:\PS> But when I run it in the task scheduler on the server, my script never runs. (The task seems to be running since it creates an XML file but this one never gets processed and I do not see any errors.) The task is set to run with the lowest user permissions. When I run the script directly from the powershell console I get this: C:\Users\admin>ps> C:\Users\admin> C:\Users\admin>cd c:\scripts\test C:\scripts\test> C:\scripts\test>test.ps1 Starting with a clean state... C:\scripts\test>exit [DONE] Cleaned up local state at: Thu Apr 5 12:28:14 2016 C:\scripts\test>exit This happens with a few different scripts including a script that creates an XML file from an imported CSV file. I am not very familiar with the script environment and none of the references I found on StackOverflow and Google help me. I am not sure what else to try. A: A good option would be to use the Server Manager, first create a local Powershell-PSRunner on your server, then use the script download button to download the script from a server and install it from

Minisipserver2812keygenQ: Getting values from radiobutton fields in python/linux I have a python script that gets values from a radiobutton for groups of radiobutton fields for each of several forms. My radiobutton field names are: field1_radio, field2_radio, field3_radio, etc. I then save this data to a database using sqlite3. There is then a "sub" form that has more fields than the form from which they were originally taken. How can I get these values after the "sub" form is opened? At the moment, I have been trying this: `def from_list(self, list_): fields = list_[0].get_fields() for index in xrange(0, len(fields)): self.fields[index][1].value = fields[index][1].get_value()` However, this does not work... A: You could try to cast the field to RadioField. `field1_radio = self.fields[index][1].fields[0].radio_field` you can then use the `get_value` or other method in the `radio_field`. A: RadioField objects provide `get_value()` and `get_selection()`, and have a `value` and an `index`. (`value` indicates the selected button, `index` indicates which of the possible buttons it's on.) If you're using Python 2.6, the following code gives the current values of the radio buttons in a form `import Tkinter root = Tkinter.Tk() form = Tkinter.Frame(root) form.pack(fill="both") radio_1 = Tkinter.Radiobutton(form, variable=Tkinter.IntVar(), text="None", value=1, command=lambda : print "radio_1 value:", radio_1.get(), side="left") radio_2 = Tkinter.Radiob`
